Courses

Childhood Education and Care

The Bachelor of Early Childhood Education and Care (Birth-5) aims to develop early childhood teachers who can integrate theoretical knowledge into practical education and care skills in the workplace.

There is a strong, applied learning focus to this degree so that when you graduate, you'll be prepared to work in a variety of settings including long day care, preschool, integrated child and family services and early intervention services.

The academic and theoretical content are supplemented by work experience which will allow you to apply what you've learned in a real world environment.

You will study child development and pedagogical practices, ethics, diversity and social justice. During your work placement, you will have the opportunity to test your theoretical understanding in a real workplace.

The Diploma of Children's Services course teaches students to manage a Child Care Centre. You will learn the legal requirements of the child care industry and in

most Australian states this is the highest qualification required at Director or Service Manager level for children's services centre-based care.

You will learn how to plan, implement and manage children's programs and services in accordance with governmental regulations as well as how to effectively manage staff and volunteers.
